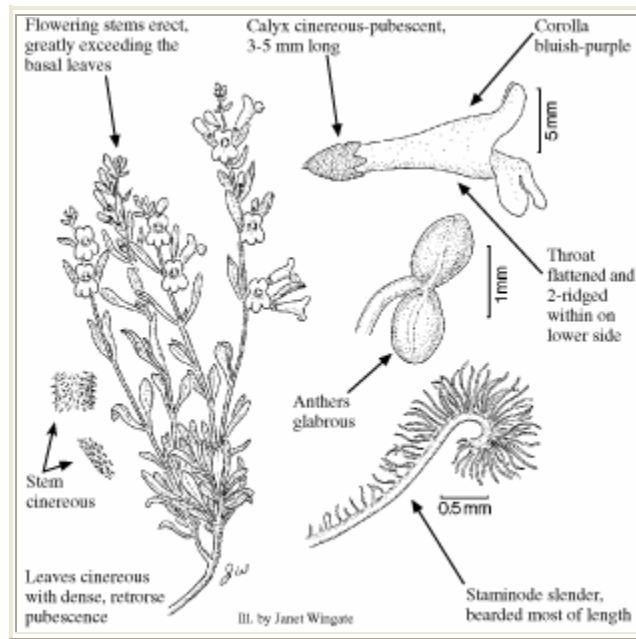

**Scrophulariaceae (Figwort Family)**

**Look Alikes:** Distinguished from other species by its mat-forming habit, small basal leaves with dense retrorse pubescence, and specific habitat.

**Flowering/Fruiting Period:** May-early June/June.

**Habitat:** Barren gray adobe hills of Mancos Formation shale where there is a relatively high amount of moisture (in drainage areas or on the north sides of hills). Clayey, alkaline soils; associated with saltbush and/or sagebrush. Elev. 5100-6500 ft.

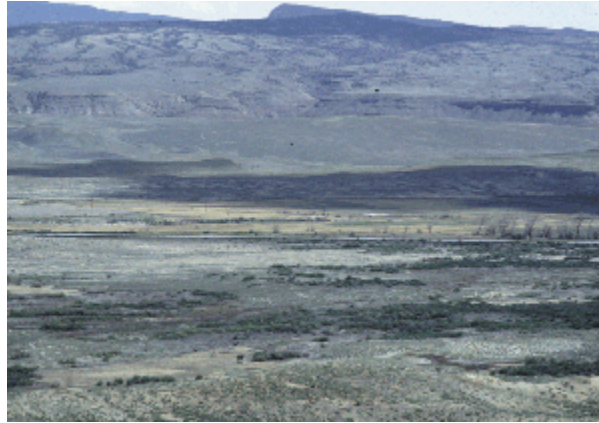
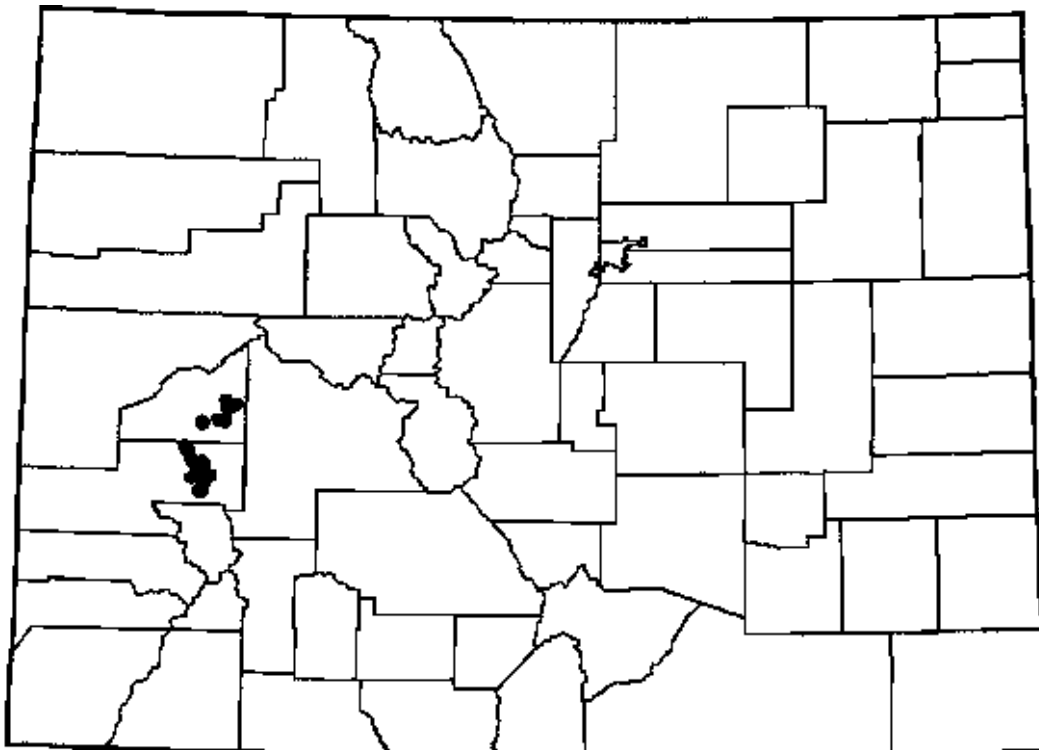
