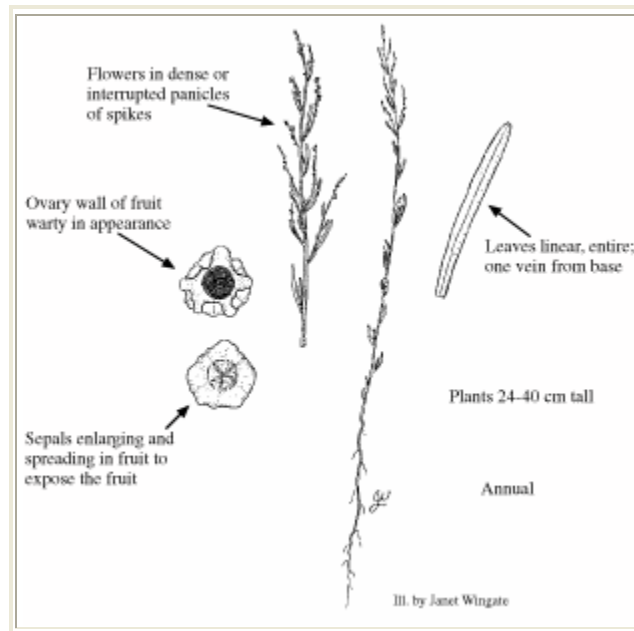

Chenopodiaceae (Goosefoot Family)

Look Alikes: Distinguished from *C. berlandieri*, *C. incanum* and *C. pratericola*,

with which it often occurs in mixed populations, by its linear leaves with a single vein, partially fused sepals that spread at maturity revealing the reddish-purple fruit, and larger fruits.

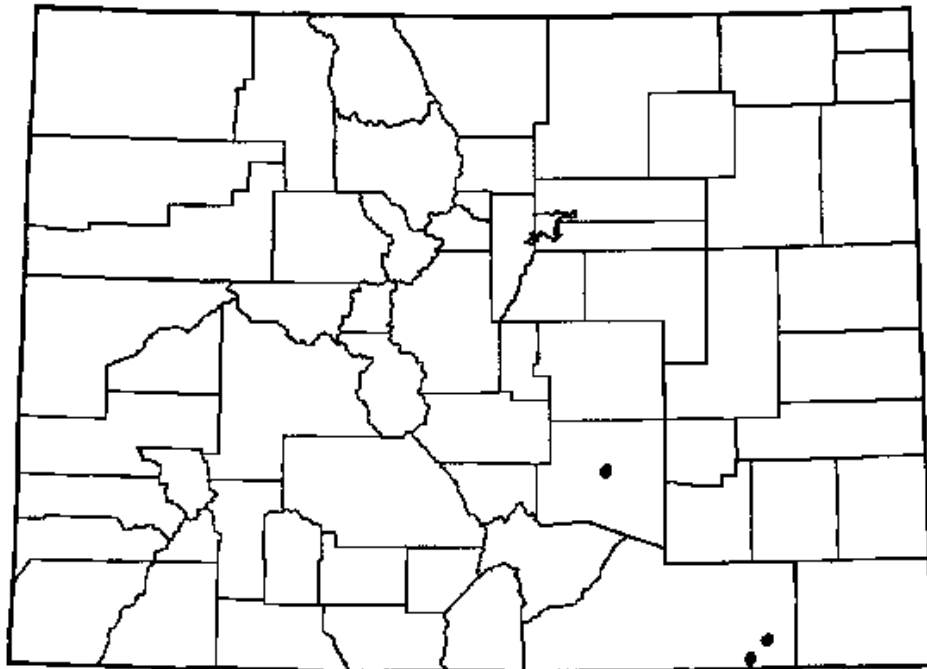
Flowering/Fruiting Period: July-August/August-September.

Habitat: Sandy soil on dunes, stabilized sand in blowouts. Elev. 4000- 5500 ft.
