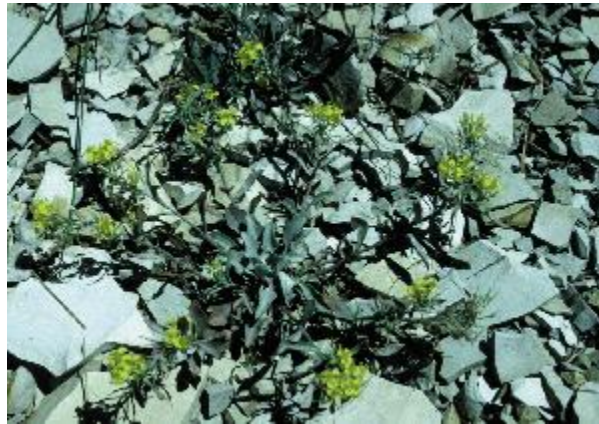

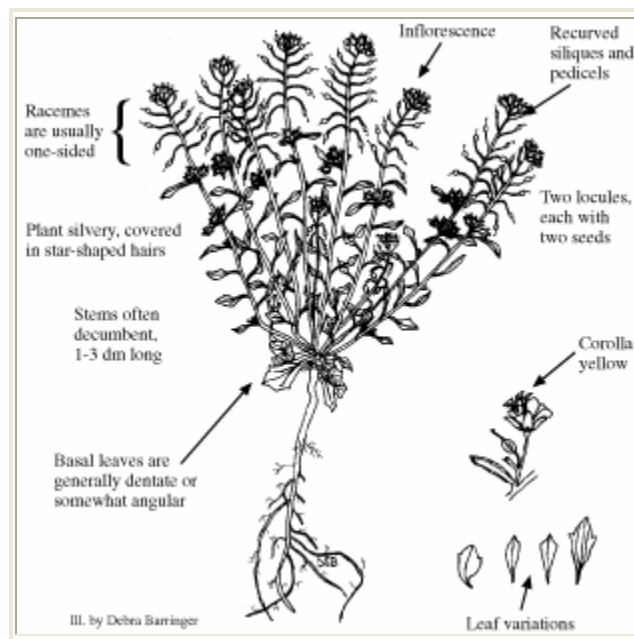

Brassicaceae (Mustard Family)

Look Alikes: *L. ludoviciana* racemes are not secund; and basal leaves are involute and usually entire.

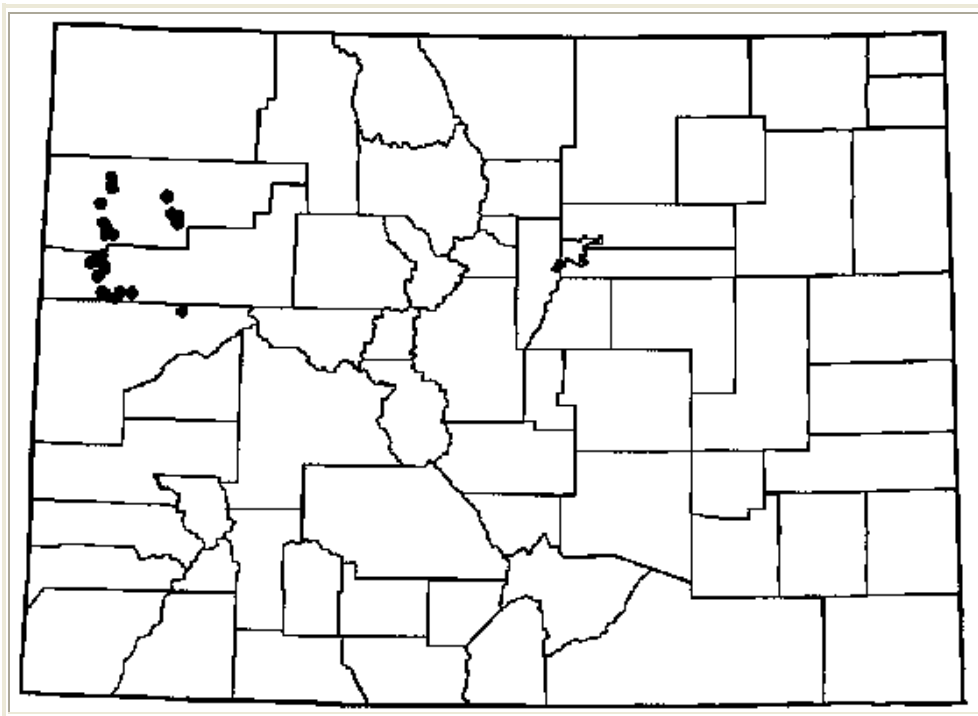
Flowering/Fruiting Period: June-early July/July.

Habitat: Shale outcrops of the Green River Formation, on ledges and slopes of canyons in open areas. Elev. 6200-8600 ft.
