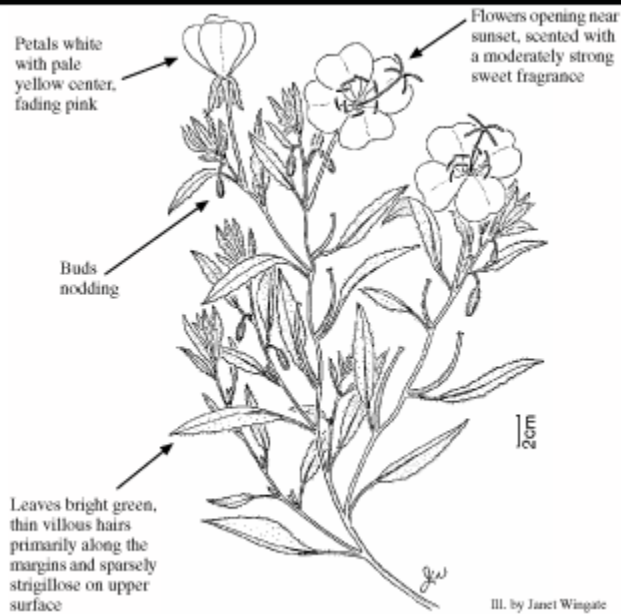


*Oenothera kleinii*

**WOLF CREEK EVENING PRIMROSE**



**Onagraceae (Evening-Primrose Family)**

**Look Alikes:** Differs from other *Oenothera* species in Colorado in flower color, and in flower size (petals over 4 cm long).

**Flowering/Fruiting Period:** Flowers in September.

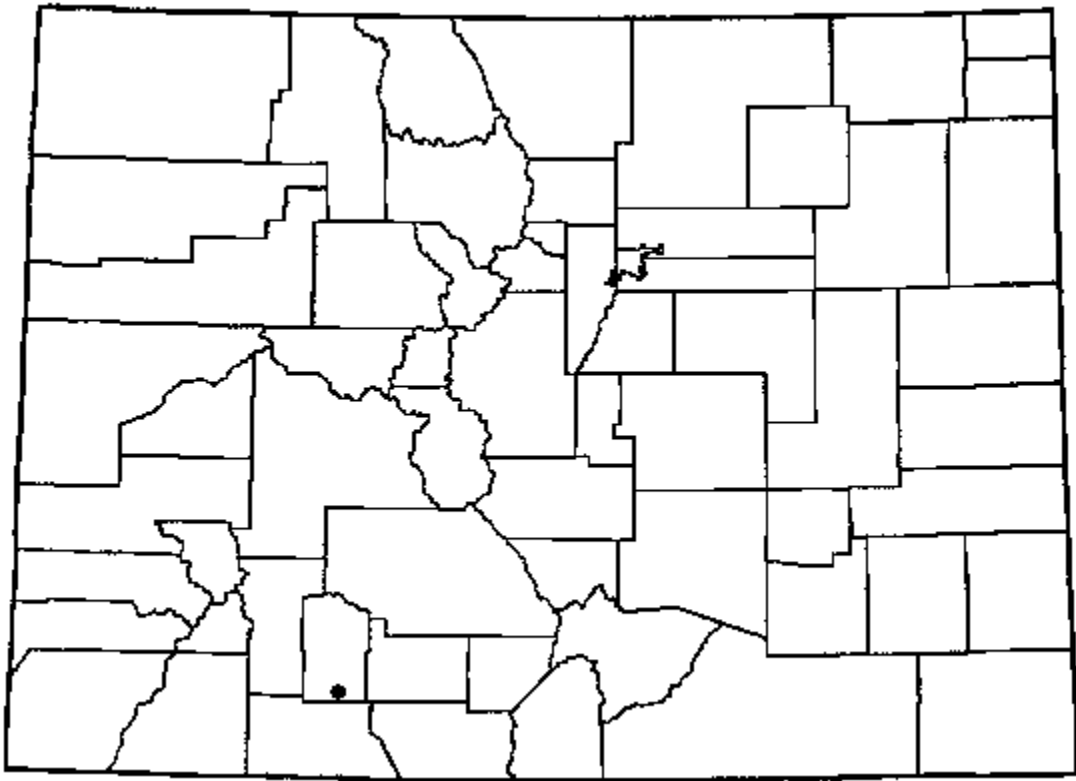
**Habitat:** Talus slopes and streambanks, in rocky soils derived from Tertiary volcanics, in mixed conifer forest. Elev. 8760 ft.

**Distribution:** Colorado endemic. Mineral Co. near Wolf Creek Pass. Entire

population/species was eliminated by road construction in 1981 and 1982.
