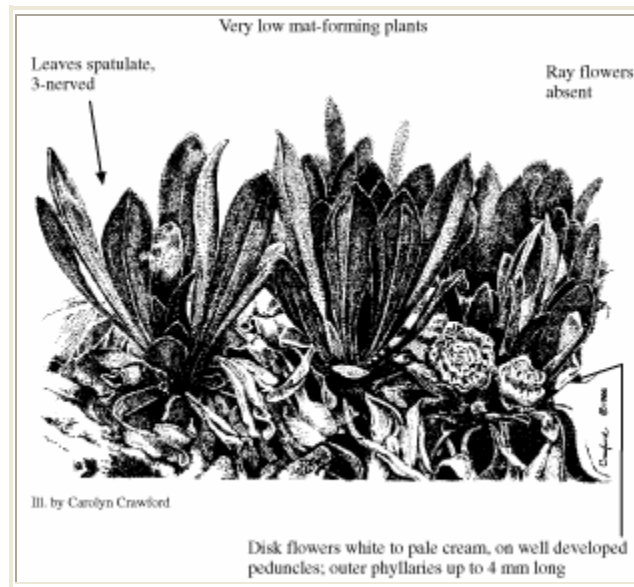

Asteraceae (Sunflower Family)

Synonym: *Parthenium tetraeuris*

Look Alikes: *B. alpina* has glabrous achenes and is only known from Weld Co. The three veins in the leaves of *B. tetraeuris* distinguish this species from similar cushion plants in its habitat.

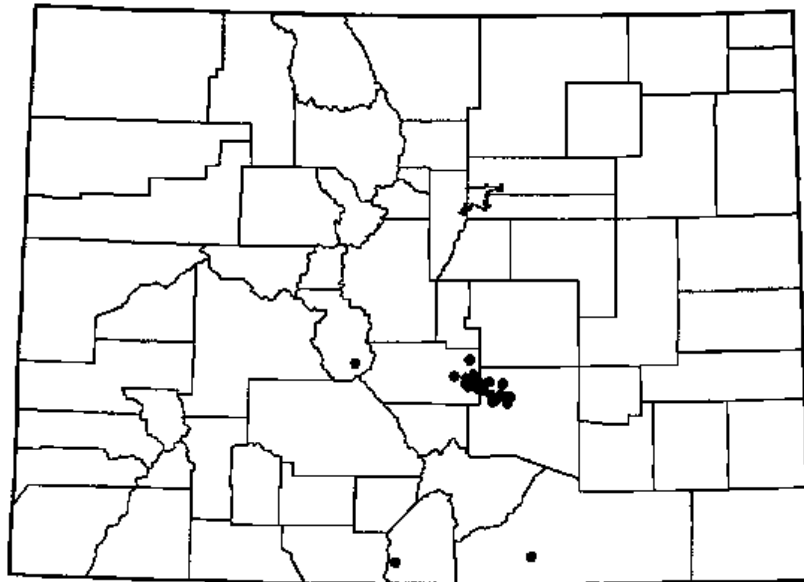
Flowering/Fruiting Period: April-May/late May-June.

Habitat: Tops of cliffs and bluffs of a variety of rock types; in open pinyon-juniper stands. Elev. 4800-5600 ft.
