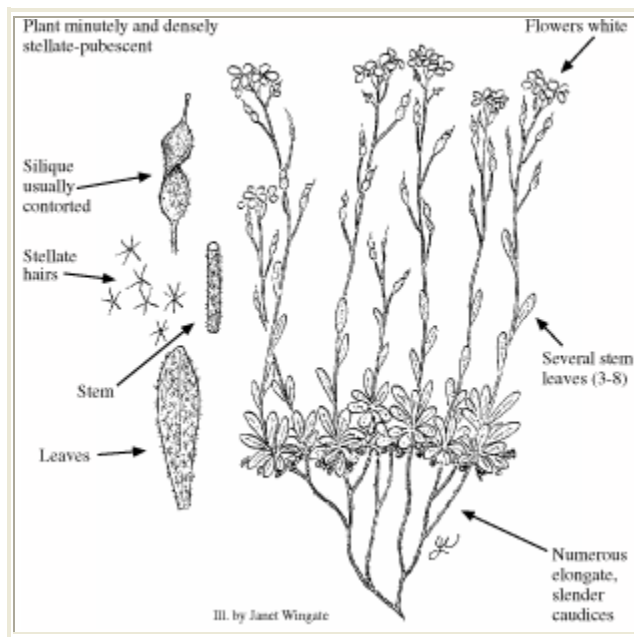

Brassicaceae (Mustard Family)

Look Alikes: Distinguished from *D. cana* in being much more finely and densely stellate-pubescent; also, *D. cana* grows in open sites in dry tundra.

Flowering/Fruiting Period: June-July.

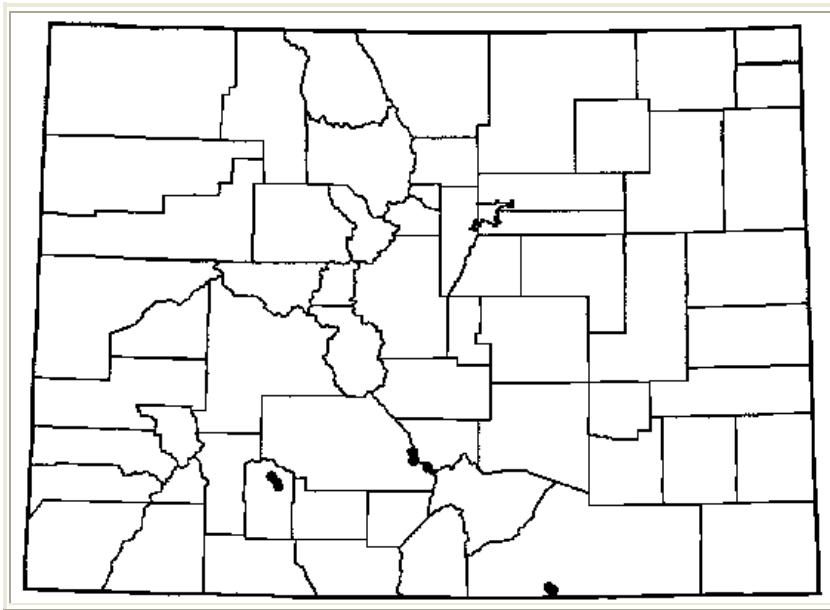
Habitat: Talus slopes, in crevices and between rocks in shaded

protected sites. Elev. 8000-11,000 ft.
